
Procedure INFO_RESU

1 Goal

To print the list of the fields and the components of these fields present in a structure of data result.

2 Syntax

INFO_RESU    (
♦  RESULT =  RESU,                                [result]

3 Operands

3.1 Operand RESULT

◆ RESULT = RESU,

It is with this keyword that the user specifies the structure of data result for which it wishes to see printing the fields and the components present.

3.2 Operand UNIT

◇ UNIT =

Logical number of unit associated with the file on which the structure of data result must be printed. By default, the impression is carried out on the logical unit 8 .

4 Example

```
RESUTRQU=MECA_STATIQUE (...)
```

```
INFO_RESU (RESULTAT=RESUTRQU)
```

This order will cause the following impression in the file of message:
